Please send your application form before **6 June 2025**. Submissions received after the deadline will be considered on a first-come, first-served basis, taking availability into consideration.

Note that the same congress registration cancellation policies apply to the Junior Suite service. Cancellation is granted only when a request is sent within 14 days after the contract is concluded. Also note that a partial refund is not possible.

- Parents must provide nappies and any specific equipment that their children need.

- Places are subject to availability and will be allocated on a strictly first-come, first-served basis.
- Attendees are required to remain in the congress venue while their children are in the Junior Suite.
- There is no possibility for a nap.
- Kindly respect the above-mentioned opening times of the Junior Suite service.
- Our employees are qualified first aiders but are not authorised to administer medicine to children.
- Each child is automatically accident insured for the duration of the service.
